Rapidly evolving technology, in particular artificial intelligence, is reshaping the nature of the workplace. It's redefining the skills required for success in jobs that are either changing or haven't yet been invented.

This calls for our education system to create better pathways for Oregonians to career success, especially our postsecondary institutions. More than ever, Oregonians need greater access to education beyond high school, whether apprenticeships, technical studies, or four-year, graduate, or professional degrees.

Lama Nachman is an Intel Fellow and Director of Anticipatory Computing in Intel Labs. Shane Wall is Chief Technology Officer of HP and Global Head of HP Labs. Nachman will explore the potentlial of AI to amplify human potential. Wall will peer into the future of manufacturing.

The breakout session will brief participants on a year-long initiative, soon to be launched by the Higher Education

Coordinating Commission, to develop a strategy and funding plan to dramatically improve postsecondary access and completion. That effort will include a look at rising skill needs in the workforce, education pathways for students from K12 into postsecondary education, and ways to fund better outcomes.
